

NEW PARKING OPTIONS AT FPC



Our neighbors at MFAH are expanding and, as planned, parking locations for FPC Houston are changing to accommodate this growth. **On Monday, May 22, the South Lot will close permanently so that construction can begin on the next phase of MFAH growth***. Below is a summary of new options for parking while at FPC.

SUNDAYS

Parking for Sunday worship will still be available in the North Lot, surrounding surface streets, and by valet (Christian Education entrance). In addition, the new MFAH Parking Garage, located on Montrose beneath the future Glassell School of Art building can also be used. Parking in the MFAH garage will be free with validation on Sundays from 8am-1pm. Validations can be obtained on Sundays at the Welcome Center and at the doors closest to the garage, SW Entrance (former Fit For Life doors). Parking validations can be obtained at any time during the 8am-1pm window. There is no time limit for the length of stay once a ticket has been validated. The fee schedule for parking outside of these times can be found below.

WEEKDAYS AND SATURDAYS

Monday through Saturday parking at FPC will now primarily be in the North Parking Lot. Specific instructions for this lot are below. In addition, the MFAH Parking Garage can be used on a limited basis. Short-term parking, 0-30 minutes, will be free of charge. Longer times will be charged by MFAH at the rate noted in the fee schedule below unless validation is being provided by the ministry or activity you are attending. Parking validation will be available from 7am-5pm on Monday through Friday.

NEW NORTH LOT INSTRUCTIONS

With the closure of the South Lot, use of the North Lot will change as follows:

Weekdays & Saturdays

Beginning Monday, May 22, there will be a single entrance to the North Lot located off of Oakdale St. An onsite parking attendant will be present to assist with parking questions and monitor traffic. From 6am-5pm, parking in this lot will be limited to FPC and Presbyterian School employees, ministries, members and guests. To ensure there is adequate parking for individuals coming to campus, drivers entering this lot may be asked who they are meeting or what event they are attending. Parking in this lot may also be restricted to FPC and Presbyterian School employees, ministries, members and guests after hours or on weekends for special events, at which time signage will be present.

Sundays

The North Lot will continue to be available for Sunday worship with no changes.

*The Welcome center driveway and parking spots located just outside the Welcome Center and SW entrance will still be available.
