Pre-Exilic: Israel

- The Kingdom in the North
- Capital is Samaria (Omri)
- They worshipped Yahweh! (...but that's what they named their 2 golden calves ☹)
 - ...And they worshipped a LOT of other gods.
- 211 years
- 20 kings, none godly

Jonah – “Through a very reluctant prophet, God shows compassion for one of Israel’s hated enemies.”

Amos – “In a period of rare economic prosperity and political strength for Israel, Yahweh announces their doom because she has failed to keep covenant with him.”

Hosea – God’s love for his adulterous bride.

Pre-Exilic Prophets → Judah

- In the south
- Capital is Jerusalem
- Worship at the temple
- 1 tribe
- 347 years
- 20 kings, some godly... somewhat
