Job Description:

First Presbyterian Church is looking for a nurturing child caregiver to assist children with special needs while they attend Sunday School. In this position a caregiver will primarily work one on one with a school aged child to facilitate inclusion in peer age group Sunday School classroom. Applicants should have experience with children with special needs of all ages. This caregiver will help provide a safe and enriching experience for children with special needs to grow in their Christian faith. Applicant must be able to communicate effectively and kindly with parents, Sunday School volunteers and church staff.

Optional opportunities to work beyond Sunday mornings in the capacity of caregiver to a variety of ages (infants, toddlers and preschoolers) are available and include regular Tuesday mornings, some Thursday mornings, and occasional evening events at the church that require childcare.
