MARRIAGE BEGINNINGS

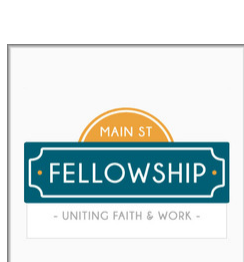
Sundays | March 3 | 9:30-10:30am | LC267

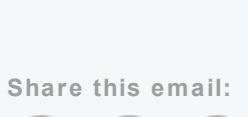
