Easter Sunday Services | Apr 21 | 8:30, 9:40, 10:45, 11:05am | Sanctuary & Grand Hall



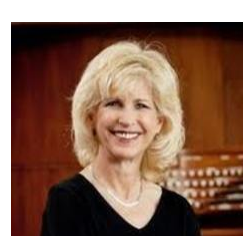
20 QUESTIONS SERMON SERIES

Deadline To Submit Nominations: Sunday, April 14

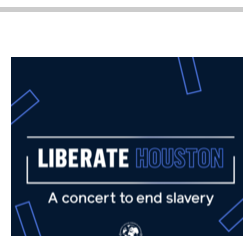

Deadline To Apply: May 5, 2019

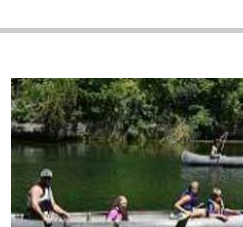

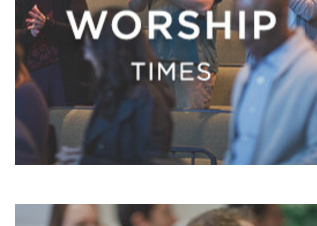
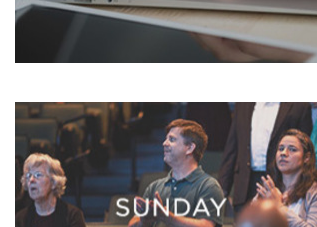
