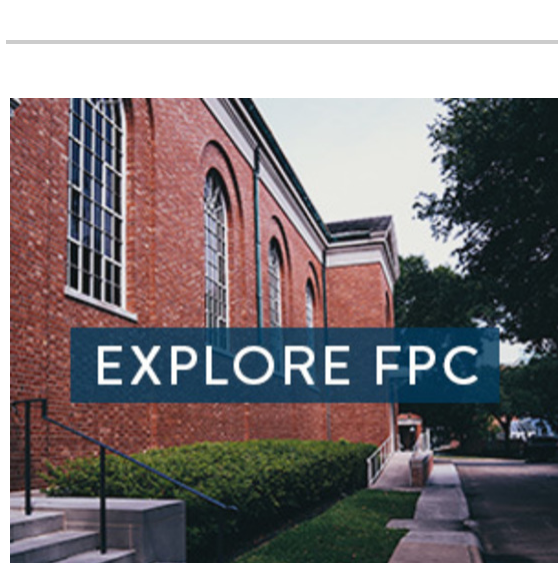

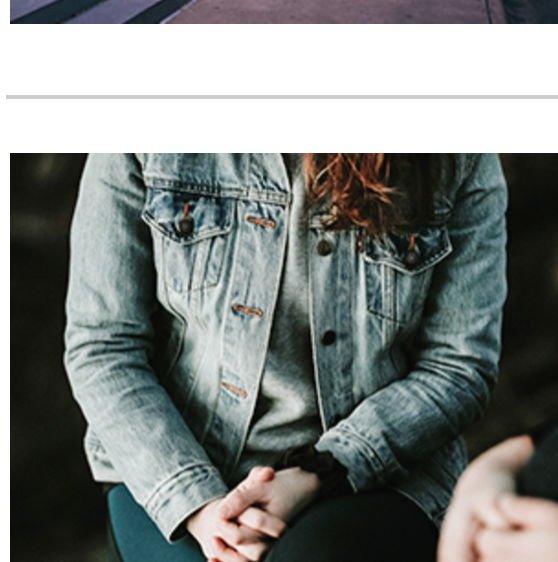


EXPLORE FPC CLASS

FPC Blood Drive

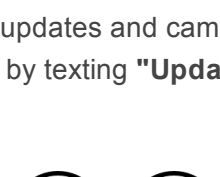

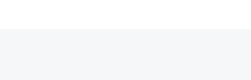

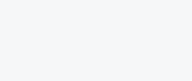
