Scripture

Genesis 1, Colossians 1

Objective

Session 2 introduces the first point of the biblical compass, God's creation. The Genesis story is one primarily of why not how. The objective of session 2 is to understand how the bible answers the question of why am I here and consider a few implications of our answer. The garden of Eden reveals a relational story—a story of all elements of creation enjoying shalom. This place is exclusively God's creation built as our home.

Questions

1. Creation is, in part, about why we are here. So, why are we here - what does Genesis 1 tell us?
2. Give an example of the earth being “fruitful” and “full” that speaks to you (think of buildings, songs, books, moments in life).
3. Creation is good yet not complete, what do you take that to mean? What is our role here?
4. Cosmos or universe—what's the difference?

Recap

Session 2 tries to show that understanding our world is a creation—not an accident—gives us a sense of peace and home in this world. Moreover, seeing the creation enchants the world—all things become touched by God because they (as we) are his workmanship.
