Scripture

Colossians 1, 1 Peter 1

Objective

Session 4 brings Jesus Christ to center stage, and we focus on **redemption**. Whatever we think redemption means, it happened at the cross. Reflecting a similar structure to the fall, redemption has an individual and a corporate dimension. ***The objective of session four*** is to bring into clear focus the all-encompassing work of Christ on the cross. That work is finished, complete, and comprehensive.

Questions

1. "Jesus Christ is the most significant person in all of history." Why is this true? What were the examples Doug gave illustrating this? Can you think of others?
2. God created all things and now he wants it all back. Every. Square. Inch. Try to think of parts of life where you act as if God does not care about them? What has this Lenten series taught you about the horizons of our faith.
3. If you are starting to see the scope and scale of the faith, where do you feel your kids are lacking in their perception of the faith? Or, do they have something to teach us about the faith?
4. What is helpful in the analogy of "map and compass"? What would you add to it, or take away?
