#### Read

Read these verses out loud: Acts 1:8; Acts 2:5-12; Genesis 1:1-2 (NIV); John 14:15-17.

## Discuss

## HEAD (10–15 minutes)

- 1. How would you phrase these passages in your own words? What stands out to you?
- 2. In John 14 the Holy Spirit is described as Counselor. In what ways has the Holy Spirit been a Counselor to you?
- 3. Acts 1:8 connects the role of the Holy Spirit with evangelism. What is your Jerusalem, Judea, Samaritan, and the ends of the earth?

## HEART (15–20 minutes)

- 1. Where are you naturally drawn to witness to Christ: in your Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, or the ends of the earth?
- 2. Where might God be asking you to witness that feels less comfortable and less familiar?

#### HANDS (10 minutes)

Brainstorm ways that you can reflect the love of God and draw people to Jesus today. Here are some possibilities:

- 1. **Your family -** Talk with your family about ideas for Project Flourish and consider volunteering for it or observing parts of it as a family.
- 2. **Your community -** While Alpha starts this week, October 6, it is not too late to ask a neighbor or a friend who is curious about your faith to join you for Alpha on Thursday evenings at 7pm with dinner. Alpha is a listening community designed to help participants explore questions about faith in a non-judging space. Everyone is welcome in this safe discussion space.   - a. Pray for our church to invite their non-Christian or Christian-but-searching friends to Alpha.
  - b. Pray for skeptics and seekers who come to the movie group, Ted Talk group, and Taco group to be willing to try Alpha.
  - c. Pray for this Alpha to be a space where we will have at least ten beginnings of people's journey of faith towards the love of Jesus.
