Read aloud the passage for this week, Matthew 1:18–25.

Head

- 1. What was Joseph's initial response to Mary's unexpected pregnancy?
- 2. The angel told Joseph not to be afraid to take Mary as his wife; what fears was Joseph likely experiencing?
- 3. How many words of Joseph are recorded in this passage?

Heart

15-20 Minutes

When he was betrothed to Mary, Joseph no doubt had good plans for a scandal-free marriage, yet God's greater plan for the salvation of humanity involved a scandalous marital beginning for Joseph. How do you respond to the possibility that obeying God may actually require you to relinquish your good plans?

- 2. Joseph obeyed God's commands in the face of considerable societal expectations regarding the acceptable response to pregnancy out of wedlock. What societal expectations might dissuade you from obeying God's commands?
- 3. Joseph responded to God's commands with obedient action, rather than words. In what circumstances are you likely to respond to God's commands with words, when action is required?

10 Minutes

Reaching Upwards: Growing in Your Relationship with God

- Meditate on Joseph's obedience to God's commands (Matt. 1:18–25, Matt. 2:13–15, 19–23), then:
 - Ask God to show you any way in which fear of failing to meet societal expectations is preventing you from obeying Him,

Ask God to show you any way in which fear of relinquishing your good plans is preventing you from obeying Him, or

 Ask God to show you any way in which obedience to Him requires action, rather than words.

Reaching Outward: Investing in Your Neighbors

- Ask God to show you any way in which you are putting off His call to help someone in a difficult situation.
- If you have been putting off God's call to help someone in a difficult situation, pray that God will grant you the courage to overcome whatever fear is hindering you, then take a step toward helping them.

Reaching Beyond

• Is there any other way God is leading you to put this week's study into obedient action, or to extend His compassion to others?
