Here to Serve is a two-year campaign and guiding vision to strengthen the ability of First Presbyterian Church to amplify the message of the Gospel for the sake of our future, our neighborhood, and our city.

For the next two years we will adopt a single fund for all giving. This "one fund" approach means that the total sum of the campaign goal includes our budget for two years of operating expenses.

Total cost for all three initatives (\$22 million) + Two years of operating expenses (\$16 million)

Total giving goal for Here to Serve = \$38 MILLION

We need you—because our goal for Here to Serve is 100% participation.

Prayerfully consider these questions before giving:

- → Am I willing to be open to being changed through participation in this campaign? How can I step outside my comfort zone and let my heart and life be impacted by Here to Serve?
- In what ways can I think creatively as I put together a comprehensive giving plan? What assets and resources could I tap into to increase my gift?
- → What are things I can choose to reduce or limit in my financial commitments during the course of this campaign in order to accelerate this vision for a cause much greater than myself?
- → How am I willing to be uncomfortable as part of a selfless sacrifice toward this vision? What can I release so that I can open myself up to the unexpected joy in this process?

Will you take time to reflect on how you can sacrificially give to Here to Serve?

We're each at a different place in what we currently give and what we're capable of giving. It might feel like you don't have capacity to contribute to *Here to Serve*. Maybe your budget is tight, or perhaps you already give to other non-profits and ministries. But our goal for this campaign is 100% participation. Because God calls each of us to give back to Him what He has blessed us with.

If First Presbyterian Church is your church home, we encourage you to take some time to reflect on how God might be calling you to sacrificially give to this campaign. Below are some strategies for how to give out of your finances and other assets and investments.

> Income-stream Giving

Start by giving 10% of your income as you receive it—whether that's your regular paycheck, bonuses, and any extra income you make through a side business.

> Sacrificial Giving

Consider making some lifestyle changes over the next two years to free up more resources in your overall financial outlook. (We have some ideas of how to practically do this on the next page.)

> Debt Rollover

If you pay off a loan or credit card in the next two years, use the resources you were putting toward that debt and roll it into your giving plan.

> Donating Assets

If you have an investment such as stocks, real estate, or other assets, there may be tax advantages to transferring ownership of the asset to FPC as a charitable donation. Because of FPC's tax-exempt status, we can sell the asset and receive full market value (less transaction costs).

Think creatively about how you can give more:

A few lifestyle changes over the next two years may have a larger impact on your ability to give than you would imagine. Here are some ideas of changes you could make:



Cut down on eating out.

The average Houstonian eats lunch or dinner out 5.7 times per week and spends \$4,600 annually on eating at restaurants.

Consider packing lunch 1 or 2 more days per week and eating dinner at home one additional day. With the average dinner out costing \$36.40 per person, you could cut down on spending \$3,785.60 over two years, just by skipping one dinner out per week.



Make coffee at home.

Cut down on buying two gourmet coffees per week, and either make it at home or drink the office brew. You'll save an average of \$8.48 per week, which adds up to \$881.92 over two years.



Reduce a movie, music, or TV streaming service.

While it's nice to watch a TV show or movie to unwind, maybe you don't need subscriptions to multiple streaming services. Cut down to one TV/movie and one music streaming service and roll the savings into the *Here to Serve* fund. Per streaming service, you'll save an average of \$200 over two years.



Reduce memberships, season tickets, and annual passes.

Whether it's a club membership, a zoo or museum membership, or season tickets to the Houston Rockets, these costs can add up. By cutting back on these memberships over the two years of the campaign, you could save thousands of dollars and redirect that money toward *Here to Serve*.
