Passage for this week: GALATIANS 5:13-26.

OBSERVE THE TEXT AND THE AUTHOR'S MAIN POINTS

- 1. "You were called to freedom." vs.13 Define the kind[s] of freedom the Apostle Paul means by this assertion.
- 2. "For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: 'Love your neighbor as yourself." v. 14. How is the whole law encompassed in this command?
- 3. "I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God." v. 21 What things? How is this warning compatible with God's grace and our freedom?

ENVISION HOW THE TEXT—WHEN APPLIED—MIGHT TRANSFORM YOUR INNER LIFE IN TERMS OF YOUR THOUGHTS, ATTITUDES, AND BEHAVIORS

- 1. What do we need for more "fruit of the Spirit" to come into our lives?
- 2. "But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by one another." v. 15. In community with other believers, some of whom are less mature, how can we become non-judgmental?
- 3. What attitudes can protect us from turning freedom into disobedience? How can we cultivate such attitudes?

APPLY THE TEXT BY MOVING FROM INWARD REFLECTION TO OUTWARD ACTION LOOKING FOR WAYS TO LIVE THE TEXT OUT IN OUR LIVES. THESE ARE SPECIFIC, CONCRETE EXAMPLES BUT THEY ARE NOT THE ONLY WAY - THEY ARE IEDA-STARTERS FOR HOW TO PUT THE WORD OF GOD INTO PRACTICE.

Reaching Outward: Investing in Your Neighbors

• Make it your practice to ask people "How can I pray for you?" Particularly ask those you encounter outside your circle of Christian friends. Let the Holy Spirit guide you whether to pray for them right then or to wait until later.

- Re-examine your life to be sure you are exhibiting to your neighbors love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Let "the fruit of the Spirit" show in your actions. What action can you take or change can you make?
