POSITION SUMMARY

The Young Adult Director will implement a comprehensive program of Christian life development for college, career, single, and married adults in our community. It is essential that this person be able to connect with young adults on a social and spiritual level, with the intent of coaching them toward Christ-like maturity.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with staff to develop and execute a strategy for ministry to the Young Adult Community, their unique characteristics, and the growth of this age group in Houston.
- Develop and personally lead evangelism and outreach to the burgeoning Young Adult community in the neighborhood around the church.
- Coordinate discipleship opportunities for Young Adults to grow in small groups and in community.
- Work with the broader FPC staff to coordinate and promote service and mission projects for Young Adults within the church (helping with children and youth) and outside of the church (service in the Museum district, Montrose, Heights, etc.).
- Provide pastoral support for Young Adults as they grow in their faith.
- Identify and equip lay leaders to assist in the work of the ministry (specifically, small group leaders).
- Maintain regular and effective communication with young adults and Young Adult leaders.
- Integrate college-aged and young adults into the corporate identity and life of the FPC congregation.
