

## Romans 8: 28-30

---

**28** And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who<sup>[a]</sup> have been called according to his purpose. **29** For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters. **30** And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.

### Questions

1. What stood out to you from this text? What was most confusing? What was most meaningful/encouraging?
2. Have you ever felt like all things are not working together for good? Maybe a situation in your life was not going as you had planned? Can you give an example?
3. Read verse 28. What would it take to fully trust that God is working in our lives, especially when our life isn't going according to our plan?
4. Read verses 29-30. What is Paul talking about in these verses? What does this say about how and why God saves us?
5. What does it mean to be *conformed to the image of his Son* (v. 29)?
6. How are you being conformed to the image of Christ? How have you changed over the past 1-2 years?
7. What is your biggest takeaway from small group tonight? What is one way you can apply what you've learned from this text to your everyday life?
