### **Read Aloud**

Passage for this week: Romans 12:9-21.

Head (15–20 minutes)

OBSERVE THE TEXT AND THE AUTHOR'S MAIN POINTS

Paul's instructions here are clear: do this, don't do that. While he doesn't expound on the term: harmony, we can infer a great deal from his use of the word.

Harmony is a musical term referring to an arrangement of many parts; rich in sound, harmony creates beauty that a single note could not create on its own. In harmony, sounds cooperate and co-create making a seamless, rich sound. In true harmony, no one note is louder than another.

- Living in harmony binds us together. How has being in harmony with brothers and sisters in Christ impacted your faith journey?
- Who, in particular, is it most challenging to live with in harmony?
- How could you bring your own gifts to contribute to the rich harmony of First Pres?
