

Application for Undergraduate Education Scholarship

Grants and Scholarships Team

The Grants and Scholarships Team of First Presbyterian Church, Houston

The Grants and Scholarships Team (GST) of First Presbyterian Church of Houston (FPC) is responsible for the stewardship of the amounts allocated by FPC's Session for expenditure from the Church's endowed and quasi-endowed funds. The GST prayerfully makes decisions about how best to administer the gifts people have given to our church, being careful to honor any guidelines that accompany these gifts. The GST is a Ministry Team reporting to the Senior Pastor and operating pursuant to a charter established by the Session. The GST utilizes Session-allocated funds to grant scholarships to accredited undergraduate colleges or equivalent institutions qualifying for use of funds under the Federal School Code for 529 plans.

Information Regarding Undergraduate Scholarship Grants Deadline

To be considered for an Undergraduate Education Scholarship, an application and all required application materials must be completed and received by the GST by one of the three submittal dates:

- June 1 for the fall school session
- November 1 for the spring school session
- April 1 for the summer school session

Administration of Scholarships

- Undergraduate student scholarship grants are awarded based on church or ministry involvement, financial need, contribution to community and academic performance.
- Undergraduate student scholarship grants for applications submitted by June 1, will be approved on an annual basis but will be funded by term or semester. Scholarship grants made for applications submitted by the November 1 or April 1 deadline, will be awarded only for the spring semester or summer session respectively.
- Students awarded an annual scholarship (June 1 deadline) will be notified with the fall disbursement that they must provide proof of enrollment by Dec 1 before further disbursements will be made.

- Undergraduate student scholarship grants are awarded in amounts of no more than \$7,500 per academic year.
- Total gifts to any one student will not exceed \$30,000 in aggregate.
- Scholarship award payments are made payable directly to the undergraduate institution.

Application Process

The following must be submitted to complete the application process:

- Completed Application for Undergraduate Education Scholarship (this form).
- To demonstrate financial need, an SAS (Student Aid Summary) is required. All financial information will be kept confidential.
- High school transcript for college freshman only and college transcript or other school record for each succeeding semester of undergraduate work indicating that the applicant is in good standing at his or her undergraduate institution.
- Summary of Previous School Year's Experience. Use Exhibit A.
- Church or Ministry Involvement Form. Use Exhibit B.
- The applicant must demonstrate sufficient connection to FPC using the criteria below to be eligible for further evaluation and award. Any of the following are sufficient:
 - the applicant is an FPC member.
 - applicant has family who are FPC members and applicant attends regularly
 - applicant is a member of a missionary family that FPC supports.
 - applicant is a member somewhere else and has a parent or guardian who is a current staff member.

Selection Criteria

Eligible applicants are reviewed by the GST based on the following criteria.

- Church or ministry involvement
- Financial need
- Contribution to community and leadership
- Academic performance
