

Sunday Morning Reboot	
8:50 AM-12:10 PM	<p>Childcare Continuous childcare available for children 2 months to Kindergarten (with large group lessons and co-curricular activities occurring throughout the morning).</p>
9 AM-10 AM	<p>Modern Worship Gathering Children in grades 1st through 5th receive their nametag sticker in Palm Court and enter the gathering with their families.</p> <p>Kids Gathering During the 9 AM worship gathering, all children will be invited to leave and join their FPC Kids teachers for an age-appropriate large group lesson and activities.</p>
10 AM-11AM	<p>Community Hour During the churchwide Community Hour, children in 1st through 5th grade have two options:</p> <p>“Kids Crew”- small group co-curricular activities</p> <p>or</p> <p>Kids Choir (PK4 through 5th grade will be able to participate in choir during this time)</p>
11 AM-12 PM	<p>Classic Gathering Children in grades 1st through 5th check in by the Kid’s Area to receive their sticker and enter the gathering with their families.</p> <p>Kids Gathering During the 11 AM worship gathering, all 1st through 5th grade children will be invited to leave and join their FPC Kids teachers for an age-appropriate, sermon series-themed lesson and activities</p>

Help! This feels confusing.

No worries! We'll walk you through it.

1. Start by selecting your family's preferred worship gathering.
2. Next, decide what your family will do during the Community Hour:
 - a. Adults: Join your existing Sunday School or Small Group class, find a new group or class to participate in, or use the hour for informal fellowship in one of our fellowship spaces (Oak Court, Palm Court, Fellowship Hall)
 - b. Kids: Your kids could go to "Kids Crew", our new time of interactive and kinetic learning or Kids Choir.

Still have questions? Here are a few we thought of:

> I want my kids to stay in the large Modern/Classic Gathering. What do I do?

We love that! Kids of all ages are always welcome and encouraged to worship with their families. However, if your kids would benefit from being in a more age-appropriate space during our worship gatherings, the "Kids' Gathering" will be a great place with them!

> Do I need to leave the worship gathering and walk to the FPC Kids space with my child?

As long as you have checked your child in through our kiosks in Palm Court/FPC Kids' space before the service and your child has their sticker on them, they can meet the FPC Kids' leaders in Palm Court (9 AM worship gathering) or breezeway (11 AM worship gathering) and we will walk them to their rooms.

> Do I need to transition my child from the 9am worship gathering to the Community Hour?

No, once your child leaves the 9 AM Modern worship gathering we will have continuous programming for them. You may pick up at the end of the Modern gathering (10 AM) or the end of Community Hour (11 AM).

> What will my child do in Kids Choir?

For all children with "choir" on their check-in sticker, we will transition them to our choir room shortly after 10 AM. When they are finished with their dynamic time of singing, learning and praising the Lord, they will transition back to The Harbor (CE 134) and be ready for pick up at 11AM.

> What's changing with the check-in process?

Make sure to check your child in as you are entering the Gathering. That way they can leave with the FPC Kids team when they are invited to join the Kids' Gathering during the service! You'll notice an additional check-in kiosk in Palm Court.

You'll also notice a second sticker will print with your child's nametag. This is the pick-up sticker! Hold on to it and bring it with you when you pick up your child.

> Where do I pick up my child?

2 months-2 years: Nursery Cove

3 years-Kindergarten: Same classroom where you dropped off

1st-3rd - The Harbor (CE 134) - This is the same room where they are currently picked up

4th-5th grade - The Anchor (formerly The Wonderground)

> Can my 4th/5th grader still self-release?

No, parents or children in 1st through 5th grade must pick up their child from their rooms and present the pick-up tag to the FPC Kids Leader. As we all become more comfortable with this schedule transition, we will revisit this policy for 4th/5th graders.

> How can I help?
